

Advertisement for Visiting Fellowship in History

Applications are invited for one position of a Visiting Fellow in the Department of History and Culture, Jamia Millia Islamia under the UGC's DRS programme for the year 2009-2010.

The fellowship is for a period of four months beginning 1st December, 2009. A consolidated sum of Rs. 15,000/- p.m. will be paid to the Fellow. The Jamia will provide accommodation to the selected candidate for the period of the fellowship (in case of foreign scholar). For Foreign scholars coming from outside India, the monthly Fellowship amount is Rs. 20,000/- (for three months only).

Fellows will be expected to conduct primary source based research on one of the following themes:

1. State formations in historical perspective
2. Social and religious formations: regional diversification social stratification
3. Social and cultural processes.
4. Identity politics in modern India
5. History of ideas
6. Paradigms and processes I: Economics change
7. Paradigms and processes II: social and political change
8. Paradigms and processes III: Environmental, technological and demographic change
9. Cultural transformations in modern India: institutionalizing cultural practices
10. Digital humanities

A monograph will have to be submitted by the Fellow in the last month of the Fellowship.

Applicants should hold a Ph.D. in History/Social Science and be below 70 years of age.
